Near the bottom of this menu, you will find a section labeled "Resolution." Click on the arrow next to the resolution that's currently set to see a drop-down of available options. Select the resolution that you believe best fits your needs. Note: Windows does its best to detect the optimal resolution for the monitor that's plugged in. The operating system marks this resolution as the "Recommended" option.

How to Change the Screen Resolution in Windows 10

The resolution thing is saved in the VM XML file, so changing VirtualBox.xml won't work, you have to modify machine.xml, where machine is the name of the VM. You can set a resolution in the display settings of the OS, then in the Machine menu disable automatic resizing. That should keep the VM at 1024 x 768.

I upgraded from Windows XP Pro to 7 Ultimate (64-bit) on my home server w/the GeForce 9500 GT card. I have no issues with my primary monitor (I-INC AG191D) running a screen resolution of 1280x1024. My second monitor (I-INC iF251H) supports 1920x1080 screen resolution. When I was running Windows XP, I had no issues getting the higher resolution.
