Endymion: A Poetic Romance. London : 1818. First edition, very scarce first issue unrestored in original boards. Endymion was the second of only three lifetime publications by Keats, comprising his longest single sustained poem, famous for its opening line: "A thing of beauty is a joy for ever".

John Keats wrote sonnets, odes, and epics. All his greatest poetry was written in a single year, 1819: "Lamia," "The Eve of St. Agnes," the great odes ("On Indolence," "On a Grecian Urn," "To Psyche," "To a Nightingale," "On Melancholy," and "To Autumn"), and the two unfinished versions of an epic on Hyperion.
